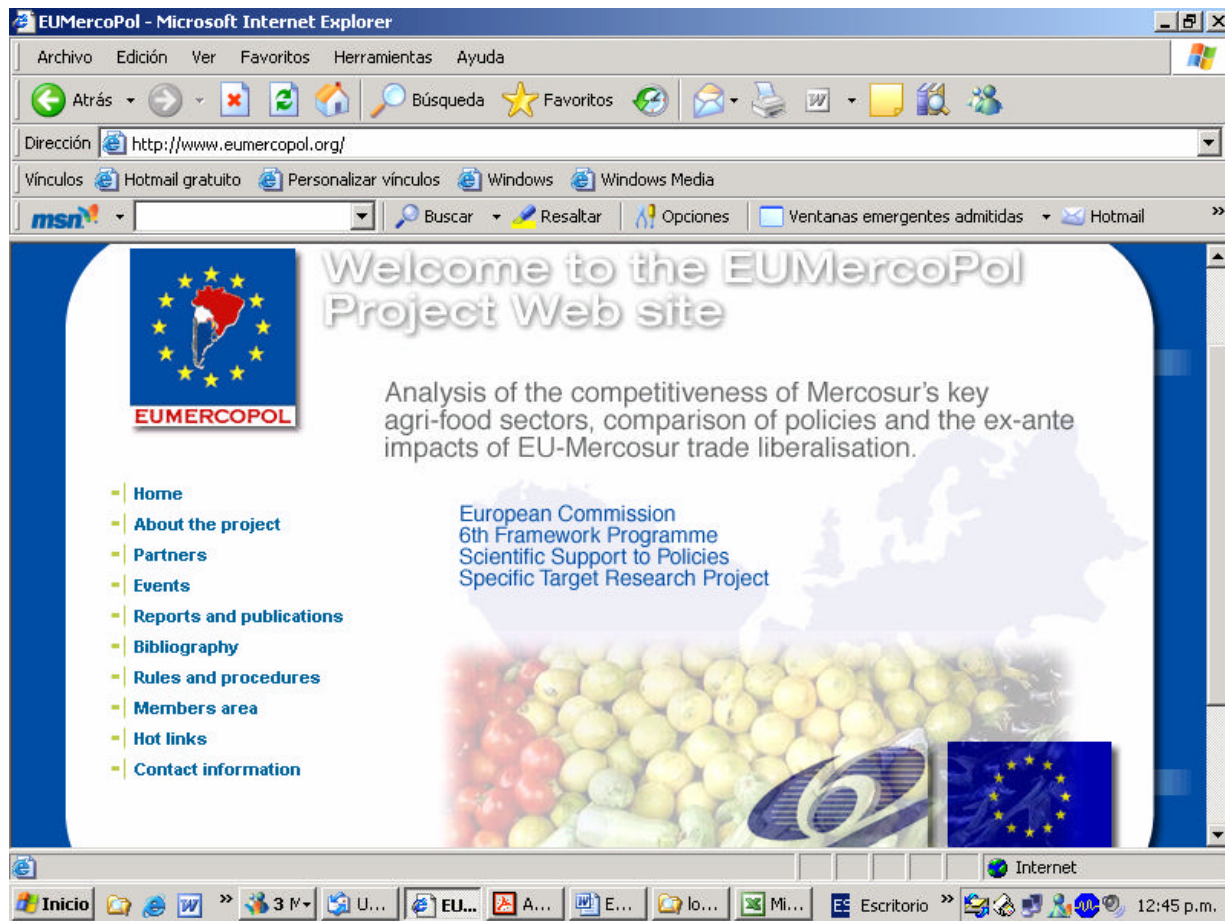

(1) EUMERCOPOL's official project web-site is at www.eumercopol.org. Please surf the site in order to learn about its contents.



(2) An IT expert and current web-master, Ing. Gonzalo Gutierrez, of the University de la República de Uruguay, was contracted per 1 April 2005. EUMERCOPOL's web-site domain was negotiated with an Argentine company in May 2005. A trial web-page was uploaded in mid-May. The official web-page was operational for the project kick-off meeting on 30 May 2005.

(3) All different sections of the web-site are functional and updated, except for the "members area" which is still under construction, pending internal discussions on the precise differentiation of public vs. members-only information.

(4) The web-site is an important project coordination and output diffusion instrument. The web-page is weekly updated. Project partners are informed twice-monthly about new items added to the web-page. An internal project IT working group evaluates and monitors the web-page's "contents and performance", and formulates recommendations to the web-master.

(5) The project's web-site is dynamic and hence will evolve over time in order to better answer new demands or opportunities. As such, project coordination, will periodically report to the Commission on the web-site's evolution.
